### SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

To bring out the paschal character of baptism, it is recommended that the sacrament be celebrated during the Easter Vigil or on Sunday, when the Church commemorates the Lord's resurrection. On Sunday, baptism may be celebrated even during Mass, so that the entire community may be present and the necessary relationship between baptism and the Eucharist may be clearly seen. Baptisms are to be celebrated in a Church. Except in the case of danger, baptism should not be celebrated in private houses.
