"When I first started this process, I thought of Confirmation as a duty instead of a gift. Now I know that I need to be "sealed with the Holy Spirit."

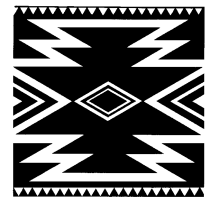
"By making my Confirmation it is not the end of the journey but just the beginning. By making my confirmation I personally believe it will benefit me in life."

SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

The profession of faith is made by the parents and sponsors on behalf of the child. Since they have accepted the responsibility of teaching their child about the faith, they are then invited to renounce sin and Satan and express their profession of faith in dialogue form based upon the Apostles Creed. According to some early tradition, the renunciation was done while facing the west the place of sunset and darkness, while they turned to the east and the rising sun for their profession of faith.
