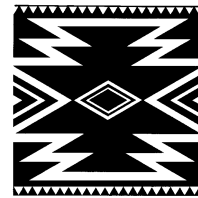

## SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

A second anointing follows the baptism proper of each child. This second anointing was originally done by the bishop in the early church and forms the basis for the present celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation. The oil used for this second anointing is called Chrism. The name comes from the same Greek word that we use as a title for Jesus, the Christ, or Messiah - the anointed one. The crown of the child's head is anointed and the prayer that is said evokes the mission of Jesus as priest, prophet and king. These children will be called upon to likewise serve in all three roles. Through this anointing, they have been christened.
