SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

A second anointing follows the baptism proper of each child. The crown of the child’s head is anointed and the prayer that is said evokes the mission of Jesus as priest, prophet and king. These children will be called upon to likewise serve in all three roles. Through this anointing, they have been christened. Chrism is again used when the Bishop confirms candidates and when he ordains young men priests. The bishop also uses Chrism when he dedicates and new altar. Its sweet smell is very distinctive.
