THE JOY OF LOVE

The following is a series of comments and excerpts from the Apostolic Exhortation *Amoris Laetitia*. Chapter one of the document proceeds to examine the scriptural roots for the reflection on the family: Paragraph 9 considers the account of Genesis, Pope Francis expounds: At the centre we see the father and mother, a couple with their personal story of love. They embody the primordial divine plan clearly spoken of by Christ himself: "Have you not read that he who made them from the beginning made them male and female?" (*Mt 19:4*). We hear an echo of the command found in the Book of Genesis: "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and cleave to his wife, and they shall become one flesh."
