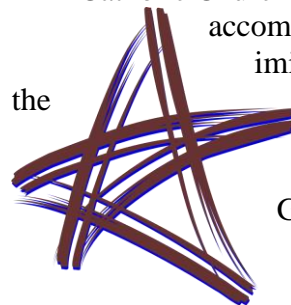

This week end we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany also called in many Latin countries the Feast of the Three Kings. It is called Epiphany because it is the manifestation of Jesus as the Son of God. For Orthodox Christians and the Eastern Rite Catholic Church, this "little Christmas" is accompanied by the giving of gifts in imitation of the Wise men giving the infant Gold, Frankincense of myrrh. The only reference to the star comes from the Gospel account of St. Matthew that is proclaimed for the day. We should take it to mean that of the Son of God shines forth of this day.

Isaiah 60:1-6 The prophet speaks of all nations seeing the glory of God.

Ephesians 3:2-3,5-6 Paul speaks of the heredity that Christians share, that we are co-partners in the promises of Christ.

Matthew 2: 1-12 The account of the journey of the magi suggests that all who honestly search for the Lord, regardless of their background will find Him.

Discussion Question: Where do we search for the Lord? How do we adore Him?
