SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

The celebration of the sacrament is immediately preceded by: the solemn prayer of the celebrant, who, by



invoking God and recalling his plan of salvation, blesses the water of baptism. This blessing may take several forms. The first form recalls the many uses of water and water imagery in the Bible: it cleanses; it restores and nourishes life; and it also destroys. The celebrant prays that God send forth His Spirit to make the waters for baptism holy and living waters.
